

THE BEST OF PRAGUE

Departure: every day at 11:00, 14:00 hrs

Short on time, but long on interest?

This walk is designed especially for you if you are spending only a day or two in Prague. In one afternoon you will criss-cross the Medieval center of the city, taking you along the **King's Coronation Way**, recapping the most **important historical events**, while briefly **introducing the basic architectural styles** Prague has to offer from its thousand-year history. A quick visit to the former **Jewish Ghetto**, one of the largest in Europe, will give you a chance to peek into its **ancient cemetery and synagogues**, as well as to hear something from its fascinating **history, traditions and legends**.



Following in **Franz Kafka's footsteps**, you will cross over **The Charles Bridge**, one of Europe's oldest stone bridges. A short tram ride up the hill will take you to **The Strahov Monastery**, where a spectacular vista of the whole city opens up below you. We will then walk downhill, passing the **pilgrim site of Loretta**, on through the medieval town of Hradecany, and come to **Prague Castle**, the largest castle complex in Europe. Here you can admire the place where the monarchs used to be crowned at **St. Vitus Cathedral**.

Finally, you will take a walk through **The Golden Lane - home of alchemists, goldsmiths, and for a time of Kafka** and at last descend the **101 steps of The Old Castle Stairs** back into the city.



Little Venice

A ROMANTIC BOAT RIDE

Departure: every day at 10:00, 14:00 hrs

If you want to have a **completely singular experience of exploring Prague**, this is precisely the right "walk" for you.

In the first part of this walk a guide will take you to the more important parts of Old Town, then you will finally arrive at Charles Bridge, where the heated boat cruise begins. Firstly, you will have a unique chance to admire the only remaining arch of the **former Romanesque Judith Bridge dating back to the 12th century**. We then sail to the **Certovka Canal**, a kind of a **water lagoon** next to the **Lesser Town Bridge Tower**, and the **old wooden mill wheel**. You will enjoy **marvelous views of the Charles Bridge and Prague Castle from a completely different perspective**. In Prague you can find almost everything - even Little Venice. Don't follow the crowd. **Enjoy a bit of sailing, drink, refreshment and magnificent passing views!**



The Old Jewish Ghetto

FRANZ KAFKA & THE OLD NEW SYNAGOGUE

Departure: every day at 11:00 hrs

Duration: 2 hours

Optional entrance to the Old new synagogue

Meeting point: Old Town Square - the Astronomical Clock.



This walk traces the history of the **largest ghetto in Europe**. It's a story that embraces the **poverty of the pogrom refugees** and the **glittering success of the Jewish people**. You will have a chance to go deeper into the **traditions, history, customs and legends** of the nation which was chosen by God. Come and explore with us this **former Jewish Ghetto**, its **synagogues and cemetery**, learn why the people had to be **buried 10-people deep with one atop the other**, and who exactly was the famous "Golem". Also discover why **Adolf Hitler** didn't want to destroy the Jewish Ghetto and Prague itself. Of course, you will have a chance to visit the places connected with the **life and works of Franz Kafka**.

The Communist Walk

VELVET REVOLUTION

Departure: every day at 10:30 hrs

Learn the most important facts from the rather tragic history of the new Czechoslovakian state. A visit to the memorial places of **Wenceslas Square**, today's business, commercial and social centre, will take you back in time to the year **1918 and the establishment of Czechoslovakia**, to **1948** when the **communists violently** took over the country and nationalised all personal property, to **1950** when most of the political executions took place, and inevitably to **1968 - the year of the Russian invasion, when many people emigrated and many committed suicide in distress**. You shall learn the **reason for the self-immolations by fire of two young Czech students** and you will also be shown where the Velvet Revolution took place in 1989 and all its consequences.

The Grand Castle Walk

After crossing Manes bridge, we will begin in the **Wallenstein gardens**, which include several displays of Mannerist art. We will then ascend the **New Castle Stairs** and discover a spectacular view of the Prague Landscape. After watching the **Changing of The Guards** we enter the castle itself. First, **St. Vitu's cathedral**, where we will see the **Underground Royal Crypt and the tombs of Illustrious Czech Princes, Bishops and Czech Patrons**. Leaving the Cathedral, passing the **superb Gothic-style mosaic illustrating the Day of Judgement**, we proceed to the **Old Royal Palace**, the original Royal seat of Czech kings. Inside is found **Vladislav Hall, scene of Medieval Jousting Tournaments**. Moving onto the legendary 'Golden Lane', the residence of **Rudolphian alchemists** as well as **Franz Kafka** - we will visit the smallest house in Prague. After another breath-taking view, we descend the 101 steps of the Old Castle Stairs.

Miss this, and you have simply missed Prague!

Stepping back through the centuries, you will have a unique chance to be



astonished by the **Gothic Tyn Church**, the picturesque **Ungelt, St. Jacob's Church** where many **kings' weddings** took place, the **Art Nouveau Municipal House**, the magnificent **Powder Gate**, then on to **The Estates Theatre** where **Mozart** introduced his famous opera "Don Giovanni" in **1787**, and **The Carolinum - the oldest University in all of Central Europe**. Continuing through the narrow streets, you will appear in front of **The Clementinum - the second largest complex after Prague Castle**. After

exploring the **Charles Bridge**, our walk will take you to the hidden **parts of Kampa Island**, lying between the **Vltava river and the Certovka Canal**. On our way, you will see the church of **The Knights of Malta Order** and the famous **John Lennon Wall**.

During our walk, you will witness something you might term "an **open-air gallery of architecture**" since almost every style is to be found here. In a two-hour walk, you will be able to surely recognise and see the finest examples of the **Gothic, Renaissance, Baroque, Neo-Classical and Art Nouveau** styles.

Following the Royal Route up to **Prague Castle**, you will have a break in an **authentic medieval restaurant**

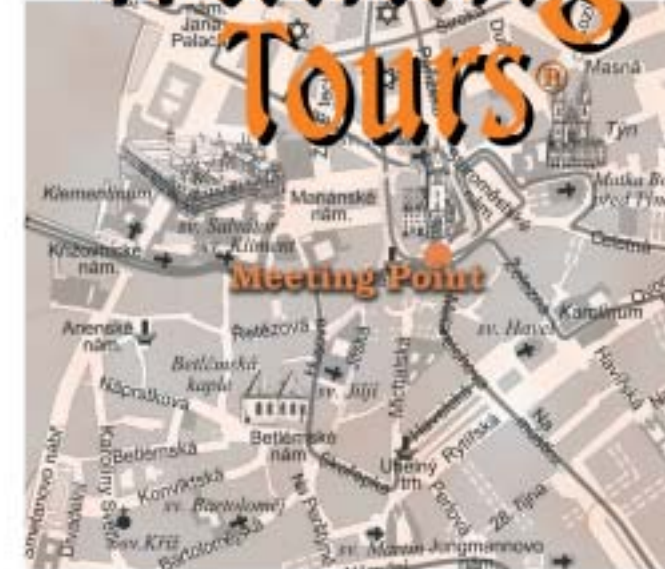


for lunch. Shortly thereafter, you reach **Hradcany Town** with the most spectacular panorama wherein you will understand why Prague is called "**the city of a hundred spires**." Your walk will continue on through **Mathias Gate** to **St. Vitus Cathedral**, the coronation and burial place of the Czech kings whose **construction took 1,000 years** and then to **St. Wenceslas Chapel**. From here you will finally arrive at **The Golden Lane**, that quaint, picturesque place of residence of the Rudolphian alchemists, where you will have the chance to see the castle ramparts and exhibition of medieval arms and torture instruments.

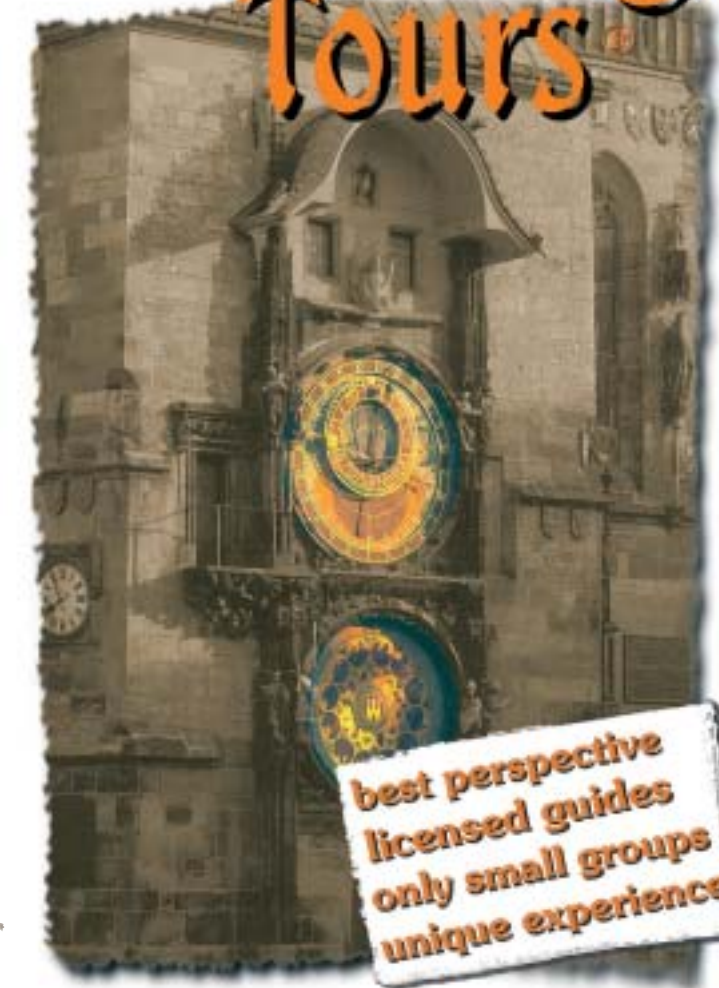
